You clearly put real time and care into building your preschool library, and that came through in the way you explained each book and connected it to children's learning. I could see that you were thinking carefully about what books offer preschoolers, not only in terms of literacy, but also in terms of social emotional growth, problem solving, imagination, friendship, family, and community. Your reflection also showed strong self-awareness and helped me see the kind of teacher you are becoming. You have a clear appreciation for books that help children feel seen while also opening the door to new experiences and perspectives.

What stood out most to me was the range of books you included and the consistency of your explanations. You did a nice job discussing why books matter for young children and how they can support development in different ways. I also appreciated the attention you gave to diversity, representation, and choosing books that can act as mirrors and windows for children. As you continue growing in this work, I would encourage you to keep pushing yourself to move even more into the teacher lens by making your classroom use of the books as specific and concrete as possible. Overall, though, this was a strong project that showed genuine effort, thoughtful book choices, and a growing understanding of how to build a meaningful preschool library.
